A six week ski program runs from late-January to Early March. Students receive a weekly, two hour lesson, lift ticket and ski equipment for a tuition of \$240. Scholarship are available to those in need. Skiing apparel, goggles and helmets can be loaned during the lesson free of charge. The program takes place at Ski Santa Fe on Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. It also takes place at Sandia Peak on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
