School Training for Engagement Planning (STEP) workshops are facilitated one day sessions for groups of school staff who are leading family engagement efforts. Group participants may include the school administrator, Family Liaison and Community School Coordinator, as well as other key personnel and families. Participant groups will learn about family engagement strategies and best practices and will be supported in the development of a comprehensive research and data based Family Engagement Action Plan. Schools will receive follow-up coaching and technical assistance to ensure that their plan is implemented and their outcomes are met.
