We use our resources and influence to create new prevention and intervention initiatives as well as stop the hundreds of drug traffickers who travel through our reservation's major highways – contaminating our ancestral homes with their poisons. We further dedicate our time and endurance in supporting merchants in reservation border towns to stop selling alcohol and products used for inhalants to our underage youth so that they don't place our next generation at risk of the centuries of substance abuse that have caused so much death and disease.
