We share a deep and abiding respect for and understanding of Andean culture and people. We believe in the capacity of Andean people to create self-sustaining activities that will improve their living standards and quality of life.We bring diverse talents, interests, and capacities to our endeavors, creating an operating board that carries out distinctive activities in each community. We use our diverse talents to create synergies among projects, each individual project supporting the others and designed to empower communities. We intentionally work with highly-motivated associations within communities, a process that leads to capacity-building in separate areas of development, expanding from individuals and small groups to the larger, entire community. Whenever possible, we use principles of micro-lending and rotating loans to underwrite projects and to enable communities to sustain development. We work in ten communities. Our projects include medical and dental campaigns, micro-loans for improving agricultural production, scholarships for rural youth to attend university, artisan and tourism promotion, and rural education.
