Transportation services are available Monday through Friday from 8:15 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for seniors age 60 and over. Rides to medical appointments are given priority over all other rides. Transportation reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance and before 4:00 p.m. There is a suggested donation of .50¢ per ride or a book of 25 rides is available for a suggested donation of \$10.00, saving you \$2.50. To schedule a ride call (505) 955-4700.
