CELEBRATION: We celebrate Dr. King's birthday on the third Monday of January in order to familiarize the public with his life work, teaching, and contributions to both our nation and the world. We involve young people from various cultural, racial, and ethnic backgrounds to celebrate diversity and unity. Youth groups from many cultures perform music, dance and poetry to promote courtesy, respect and understanding. Our speakers familiarize the audience with Dr. King's life work.V.
