## Family Resource Center (FRC)

The FRC includes a relaxed living room setting with a play structure and three libraries. This setting creates a comfortable place for the community to gather. Families come to the FRC to combat isolation, address children's developmental and behavioral health, learn from one another, and meet social needs. The FRC offers ongoing activities for families, such as facilitated parent discussion groups, and toddler/parent activities. Included in the FRC are three libraries; The Beth Ladino Family Resource Library offers materials related to family wellbeing, the Toy Lending Library circulates toys targeting child development and the Educational Resource Library houses curriculum to help families who are schooling from home.

FSN has multiple support groups. These groups serve families with expectant mothers, young children, kinship care circumstances, and more. FSN family support groups are designed to meet community need.

Community education is offered through parenting classes, programs in the schools, and various workshops.
