After-school support; in school program, tutoring enrichment, anti-bullying program, life skills, health and wellness and STEM activities. At our Hillside facility we offer after school programs, Spring Break Camp, in-service day camps and a nine-week Summer Camp for girls ages 5-16. Additionally, we currently offer community-based programs at several public school sites and at the Santa Fe County Youth Detention Center, as well as family and teen workshops conducted with our own participants and in collaboration with other nonprofits.

The Girls Inc. Experience helps girls to grow up: strong - girls gain knowledge to embrace physical activity, positive body image, and nutrition while decreasing or delaying substance use and risky sexual activity; smart - girls increase their love of learning, improve performance in school, and aspire to and plan for education beyond high school; bold - girls build life skills to set and achieve goals and increase resilience in the face of obstacles to live productive and fulfilling lives.
