

# Heading Home Veterans Transitional Housing Program- AOC Campus

Fifteen beds at the AOC Campus are reserved for the Heading Home VetTRAN program. This is a grant per diem program in partnership with Veterans Administration and connects eligible veterans to VA benefits, while assisting them to expedite needed services and treatment. The main focus is to assist veterans in exiting homelessness into permanent stable housing. On-site assistance is provided to our veterans by Heading Home case managers and VA social workers.Veterans who enter the national Grant Per Diem program are eligible to remain in the program for up to two years.
