Connecting families with resources (by way of referral). Assist juveniles and their families with present crisis. Reduce law enforcement time devoted to juveniles, which will enable the officer to return back to the street. Facilitate collaboration and communication among all agencies. Accelerate youth access to treatment. Reduce duplication, promote efficiency, and enhance community accessibility.
