Juvenile Probation and Aftercare - CYFD

Juvenile Probation Officers (JPOs), employed by the New Mexico Children, Youth and FamiliesDepartment (CYFD), work out of 29 local offices. The court sets the terms of probation withrecommendations from the JPO, District Attorney, and the youth's attorney. JPOs maintain contact withclients in placement. Aftercare (formerly parole) refers to the term of supervision that occurs once a juvenileis conditionally released to the community after serving a facility commitment term. Clients in aftercare are subject to being returned to detention or facility placement for rule violations or other offenses.
