## Land Grant Youth Art Outreach Program

This program serves youth living in the Land Grants of Manzano, Tajique and Chilili. The program currently runs one day a week for 6-8 weeks during the summer months. Artists and assistants from the Land Grants communities also participate in this program. This program is for children ranging in ages from 8-15. Children ages 5,6, and 7 must be accompanied by an adult the entire period of the class.

This summer the participants will learn to create painted brown paper buffalo hides while they learn about the Plains Indians, create personalized shadow boxes with the assistance of Nationally known Albuquerque artist, Goldie Garcia, customize old school hand-screened t-shirts designed by the Pop Artist Craig, design symbols and select images then decouped onto wood plaques, and back by popular demand items made from duct tape.
