Project Carino provides individual and family therapy, support groups, Big/Little Buddy Program, anti-bullying, grief and anxiety support groups and Celebrate Survival for students who have experienced a death in their immediate family. Our counselors supervise interns, consult with teachers and administrators, do crisis intervention services and provide mental health classroom presentations.
