Children who are motivated and capable of learning advanced choreography are invited to participate in after-school Advanced Training and summer programs. We also offer rigorous performing arts classes for all ages with sliding-scale tuition at The Dance Barns in Santa Fe and The Hiland in Albuquerque.
