INDIGENT WELFARE CASKET: Burial assistance up to \$2,500.00 paid directly to the funeral home for indigent casket, professional services, and transportation from the funeral home to the burial site.

DISASTER ASSISTANCE: Provides vouchers to purchase food, clothing, blankets, and towels for victims who have been burned out of their home. **BLOCK GRANT:** This program is used for self sufficiency (i.e., will assist if a person wants to go back to school or a person who has just started work but will not get paid in time to cover their rent, etc.). **LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE:** Helps those qualified individuals who live on the reservation with heating bills, weatherization, and wood stoves. All assistance is contingent upon available funds. **General Social Services ONLY.** For CPS (Child Prot **GENERAL ASSISTANCE:** Covers basic needs, for those who meet eligibility requirements.
