CASA - Albuquerque

At New Mexico Kids Matter we believe every child who's been abused or neglected deserves to have a dedicated advocate speaking up for their best interests in court, at school and in our community. When the state steps in to protect a child's safety because the people responsible for protecting them have not, a judge appoints a trained volunteer to make independent and informed recommendations to the court. That volunteer is a **CASA** - a Court Appointed Advocate. Our organization recruits, trains, educates, and empowers community members to advocate for children in foster care as volunteer CASAs. A CASA volunteer ensures that each child's individual needs remain a priority in the child welfare system. We are the only child advocacy group working in the court system that provides a caring, consistent adult focused on the well-being of a single child.
