Our substance use counselors assess the severity of addiction, develop personalized treatment plans, and provide individual and group counseling sessions to address the physical, psychological, and social aspects of addiction. We educate clients about substance use, offer crisis intervention, involve family and support systems, and refer clients to additional services when needed. By providing ongoing support and follow-up, our substance use counselors aim to help individuals achieve sobriety, enhance their overall well-being, and rebuild their lives after addiction, making our counseling services a vital component of addiction treatment and recovery.
