New Sunrise Regional Treatment Center is an adolescent residential treatment facility within the Albuquerque Area Office. Tribes served include Pueblos, Navajos, Colorado Utes and Apaches. The Girls Unit houses a total of 8 females. The Boys Units houses a total of 16 males here are 2 licensed teachers and 1 Education Assistant in our Education Department.

The following are the eligibility criteria for admission:

- Eligible for Indian Health Services Direct Care;
- Age from 13 through 18;
- Dual diagnosis (substance abuse & mental health);
- Need for more intensive treatment than is available on an outpatient basis.
