The PSD is mandated, in accordance with the New Mexico Children's Code, Section 32A-4 et. seq., NMSA 1997, to receive and investigate reports of children in need of protection from abuse and/or neglect by their parent, guardian or custodian, and to take action to protect those children whose safety cannot be assured in the home. The Protective Services Division is committed to providing for the well-being of the children in its care and to securing permanency for those children as quickly and as safely possible.
