It is a state-wide program within the Department of Health, Public Health Division. CMS serves children from birth to 21 years of age with chronic illnesses or medical conditions that require surgical or medical treatment that could limit their activity. Children/youth are medically eligible based on a diagnosis from a doctor.
