

Critical Assistance for New Mexico's Military Families

Operation Homefront's Critical Assistance Program helps military families through difficult periods by addressing financial shortfalls. Our program is designed to ensure that short-term needs don't turn into chronic, long-term struggles. Most often this means assistance with mortgage payments, rent, utilities, car repairs, home repairs, overdue bills, critical baby items, and groceries. Our process is managed by a professional caseworker who will:

- validate financial needs before support is provided
- offer assistance in the form of grants, not loans
- pay funds directly to service providers, not the military family

Through our nonprofit partners, those receiving financial assistance with rent and mortgage, utilities, and food are offered financial education to break the cycle of recurring crisis and achieve long-term self-sustainability.
