Fix the 505 is a public Spay/Neuter Program designed to help needy individuals fix their owned animals. PACA covers the cost of the surgery along with basic vaccines. Other health-related needs may be found by the Vet during the appointment. Owners will have the option to pay for these additional services. Microchips are encouraged but not paid for by this program. This program services both dogs and cats. Applying is easy; just email pacadogs@aol.com to begin the process. A volunteer will respond within 24 hours of your email with the questionnaire to begin the process. Most vouchers are issued within 10 business days.
