

# **Project Venture**

Project Venture is an evidence-based, culturally guided, outdoor experiential youth adventure program developed over decades of work with American Indian youth. NIYLP created Project Venture under the guidance of Native American elders, who emphasized using traditional culture and programs developed and implemented by Native peoples as a way to address contemporary challenges. The model promotes positive attitudes, behaviors and outcomes in a variety of experiential settings using components of traditional American Indian modes of learning and culturally meaningful service learning actitivities, and relies on Amercian Indian traditional values to help youth develop positive self-concepts, effective social skills, a community service ethic, internal locus of control, and increased decision-making and problem-solving skills. Comprised of three components -adventure based experiential learning, service learning, and culturally based leadership, Project Venture uses unique group development processes to actively engage youth in a proven and effective method of developing life skills while reinforcing traditional Native values such as family, service learning and appreciation for the natural world.
