Therefore, the Pueblo of Laguna Social Services is committed to supporting and preserving the integrity and maintenance of our pueblo families through the implementation of services specific to Child Welfare & Protection, Adult Protection, Foster Care, Crisis Intervention, Individual Indian Monies assessment and evaluation and Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA).
