With Pace, riders can now rent one of the 250 bikes from any of Pace's 50 dedicated bike racks, or from any public bike rack available throughout the city of Albuquerque. To use Pace, riders download the free "Pace Bike Share" app, available in the App Store or Google Play. Riders find available bikes and parking locations in the app and can unlock bikes at the touch of a button. Rides cost \$1 per 30 minutes, and the first 30-minute ride for every new user is free.
