The health priorities are: 1. Increase enrollment of County residents in health insurance; 2. Reduce alcohol abuse; 3. Reduce drug abuse; 4. Reduce low birth weight ; 5. Reduce suicides; 6. Increase consumption of health food

The Health Services Division staffs the Health Policy and Planning Commission (HPPC), an advisory body charged by the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners with providing guidance on health services and programming. The Health Services Division has recently launched an Accountable Health Community, with the goal of addressing the needs of individuals by connecting them with the clinical care and community services they need to stay healthy, leading to improved community health.
