

Need-Based Tuition Scholarship Fund

The need-based tuition scholarship fund serves families that deeply want an excellent education for their children but are unable to afford it. The families served by the program are almost all racial and ethnic minorities from Alameda County, California. Most are highly committed and involved working parents who travel hours per day (from Livermore, Hayward and Union City) for the sole purpose of having their children attend St. Joseph school. Many recipients live in areas with overcrowded poorly performing public schools. For parents, enrolling their children at St. Joseph is a significant improvement to their children's quality of life. The smaller class sizes, supportive community, increased individual attention, learning support program if needed, and excellent academics at St. Joseph are reasons our families identify for enrollment. Saint Joseph provides a longer school day, 8am to 3pm, then public schools and a quality before/after school program from 7:00am until 6:00pm that provides vital safe affordable support to the long days of working parents.
