The Behavioral Health Intervention Zone (BHIZ) provides services to Sierra County residents of all ages who are struggling with mental health, suicide and substance use issues. The Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant and Substance Abuse Program (COSSAP), and RISE, which connects community members who are incarcerated and/or coming out of incarceration with services to ensure a successful transition.
