Spiritual -Offers interpersonal and intrapersonal growth guided by multiple mindfulness and prayer tools that promote internal growth.

Wilderness-Offers multiple modalities that will improve overall health by diet, exercise, and wilderness education around living a healthy lifestyle with balance (i.e., high and low ropes courses, trust walk, hiking).

Psychotherapy-Offers outpatient counseling services for adolescents with various behavioral and addictive disorders.

Youth participate in a comprehensive program of adventure, spiritual, and psychological therapy that promotes the physical, educational, and spiritual life skills necessary to prepare and empower them for leadership in their communities and success in their personal lives.
